Northwest Design Group - Koviak & Vorenkamp

Lucas Porath from NDG attended the meeting to present a proposal for engineering study for Phase II of the trail, from the Hogsback Rd. on the west side to north to Riggsville and the east

side down to Hoppies. The fee is \$18,000 for the engineering study. The easement from U of M still needs to be approved. The application for MNRTF is due March 1, 2016 but the easement details can be finalized later if approval is granted. East Burt Lake Rd. will be paved shoulders as residents do not want a separated trail.

MOTION: Moved by McDougall, supported by Pillen to contract with Northwest Design Group for an engineering study for Phase II of the Burt Lake Trail in the amount of \$18,000.00; funds to be paid from the Trail Account.
