 - Been raising money and taking donations for a fire boat (pictures provided via email from Bricker and passed around) total cost is approximately \$100,000 and \$70,000 has already been raised through fundraising and foundations. Pellston is asking Burt Township for \$30,000 so the boat can be purchased by July 2023
 - Township currently has \$31k leftover in the fire account and the new fire millage will also create a surplus
