UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 1. Burt Township Flag
 - Updated estimates based on design all are applique:
 - Gettysburg Flag Works cannot embroider but can provide a center applique to be affixed \$1,586.93
 - Flagusa.com \$2,369 single side (Per Denise, they are difficult/bad attitude)

- Moritz Embroidery Works \$2,100 (Per Denise, very responsive)
- Flag for Veterans \$1,760 single side (4-6 weeks) not an option for us, only for veterans...

MOTION: Moved by Parker, supported by Hodulik to have Moritz Embroidery Works to produce an embroidered township flag for an estimated cost of \$2,100

- 2. EGLE Property at Corner of Crump Rd/Mullett-Burt Rd
 - Parker sent a FOIA request to EGLE in November they replied to all points except for the status of EGLE negotiations with the property owner, which they state is confidential
 - Report is from Feb 16, 2023 but EGLE was out in August per Kinney and they added more wells and filled barrels
 - Parker will forward the report to the Board and Larson to review
 - Koviak spoke to Kinney and she has heard nothing from EGLE
- 3. DNR Property West Burt Lake Rd
 - Matt Lincoln (DNR Real Estate division) said talks with UofM, which have been going on for some time, have stalled and they have reached a dead end. The talk now within his department is going back to the Director of the DNR and asking him to put it back up for auction next spring
 - MacArthur checked with the registrar of deeds and there is currently no lien on property by the Burt Lake Band of Odawa Indians
 - Per MacArthur, the Indian tribe is recognized by the State of Michigan but has not found any specific case law that supports a non-federally recognized tribe being exempt from local zoning

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. <u>New Employee Jim Michaud</u>
 - Recommended by Jackie, started November 11

MOTION: Moved by Hodulik, supported by Parker to confirm hiring of Jim Michaud to work the west side transfer station

- 2. <u>Camera Quote for Hall</u>
 - Representative from Sunrise Electronics came to the hall on November 29
 - Quote submitted is for 2 cameras, one aimed at the ballot box and one out to the parking lot and recording for up to 90 days \$4,190.53
 - The Township was awarded \$2,500 grant from Michigan Par Plan to help pay for it
 - Sunrise Electronics said they would have it installed by mid-January

MOTION: Moved by Hodulik, supported by Parker to approve the purchase and installation of the cameras and equipment from Sunrise Electronics

- 4. Cheboygan Road Commission bids
 - Roads in need of work rated 3 = Cedar Point Dr, rated 2 = Chickagami Trail, Feather Lane, Deerfield Lane, Elmhirst Rd, and Maple Bay Rd
 - Bids:
 - o Cedar Point Dr, 3,000 feet, tar and chip \$48, 400 (\$968 deposit)
 - Maple Bay, complete reconstruction \$246,500 (\$100k of that is excavation/grade work) by the time the work is complete the township would have sufficient road millage funds to cover the cost
 - Chickagami Trail (Maple Bay Rd to end of pavement), tar and chip \$91,200 (\$1,800 deposit)
 - Total deposit due: \$7,722.00 immediately with copy of bids
 - The road commission is offering a \$25,000 match for early submission, first come, first serve with 10 matches available
 - 2025 will be looking at Brutus Rd/Indian Point Rd

MOTION: Moved by Hodulik, supported by Kozlowski to approve the road projects for 2024: Chickagami Trail @ \$91,200, Maple Bay Road @ \$246,500 and Cedar Point Drive @ \$48,400 with deposit to be sent to the road commission right away

- PIE&G decided not to come to the planning board for their proposed tower on the east side can't get the parts to build it

Zoning Administrator's Report – Larson

- Rackspace email issue
- Jacobs property
 - o MacArthur received a phone response dictated from MacArthur's secretary and shared it with the Board
 - Power line work was done last week but they had to call Jacobs as his trailers were blocking access
 - Based on the most recent response from the Jacobs attorney and the fact the Township does not plan to re-zone the current property
 - As there are no major efforts to remove the vehicles to date, a circuit court lawsuit would be the next step MacArthur needs Board approval to begin a civil suit

MOTION: Moved by Parker, supported by Hodulik for the township attorney to begin a court proceeding with Mr. and Mrs. Jacobs for removal of all the commercial vehicles currently parked on a residential zoned area
